SPECIAL ENTERTAINMENT

Ken O'Malley and the Twilight Lords deliver an irresistible blend of Celtic traditional and American/British roots rock with energy and flair. Dublin-born O'Malley's rich, resonant voice, remarkable talent on guitar and mandolin, and engaging stage presence are supported by the extraordinary electric guitar of Cary Park, along with Will MacGregor on bass and Otis Hayes III on drums. Molly's Revenge is a dynamic, acoustic Celtic band known for its unique and infectious on-stage enthusiasm. The classic combination of bagpipes, whistle, fiddle and song— set against a backdrop of guitar, bouzouki and mandola accompaniment — guarantees an enjoyable experience for all fans of Scottish and Irish music. Their arrangements of traditional jigs and reels bring these dance tunes up to date with a driving, hard-edged accent that always leaves audiences shouting for more. Audiences love their epic sets on highland pipes and fiddle, to angelic folk songs over bouzouki and mandola, to ripping sets of Irish jigs and reels. (www.mollysrevenge.com)

John Taylor with special guest Ed Miller are two of Scotland's finest musical exports. Originally from Northeast Scotland, from an area rich in tradition, John Taylor has lived in San Jose, California for over 30 years and during that time has become one of the most popular and sought-after fiddlers for Scottish Country Dancing. He has played throughout the US and Canada, toured in Scotland and New Zealand, and has recorded albums with the dance band "Fiddlesticks and Ivory" and with pianist Andy Imbrie. Originally from Edinburgh, Ed Miller (www.songsofscotland.com), a product of the 1960's/70's folk revival in Britain, is blessed with a voice "as smooth and satisfying as a good single-malt whisky." His repertoire covers the whole spectrum of Scottish folk music, from old ballads and songs of Robert Burns to more recent songs by writers who are adding to the huge store of Scots song.

Classic Drum Major Contest - Back by popular demand is the acclaimed "Classic Drum Major Contest" featuring world class Drum Majors. The Drum Majors will parade the pipe band while showing off their skills for the honor of top Drum Major of the Monterey Games. This competition is sure to be enjoyable for all who attend.
